

EMPLOYMENT

RELATED TO TRAINING

Within the group of employed graduates, 77 percent were in a job related to the training they received, 22 percent reported that their job is not related to the training received and one percent did not indicate if their employment is related to their training.

BY INSTRUCTIONAL DIVISION

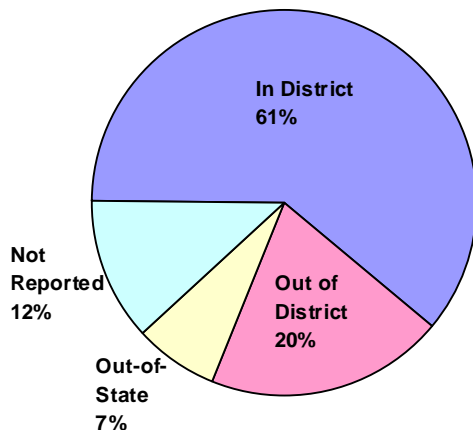
Statewide in all instructional areas, 77 percent of the employed graduates who responded to the survey obtained employment in occupations related to their training. The chart below shows the percent of those employed related for each instructional area from the highest percentage employed related (Agribusiness) to lowest (Marketing).

WHEN EMPLOYED

Of the 11,930 respondents who reported being employed, 45 percent said they became employed after their technical college training; 20 percent indicated they were employed before they enrolled; 18 percent said they got a job while they were attending technical college; and 17 percent did not indicate when they became employed.

EMPLOYMENT LOCATION



Technical college graduates overwhelmingly stay to live and work in Wisconsin and contribute to the state's economy. Eighty one percent of the employed graduates who responded to the survey are working in Wisconsin, 7 percent are employed out-of-state and 12 percent did not indicate where they are employed. Of the graduates employed in Wisconsin, 61 percent are employed in the technical college district where they received their training and 20 percent are employed in another district.
