

## EMPLOYMENT

### RELATED TO TRAINING

Within the group of employed graduates, 71% were in a job related to the training they received, 28% reported that their job is not related to the training received and one percent did not indicate if their employment is related to their training.

### BY INSTRUCTIONAL DIVISION

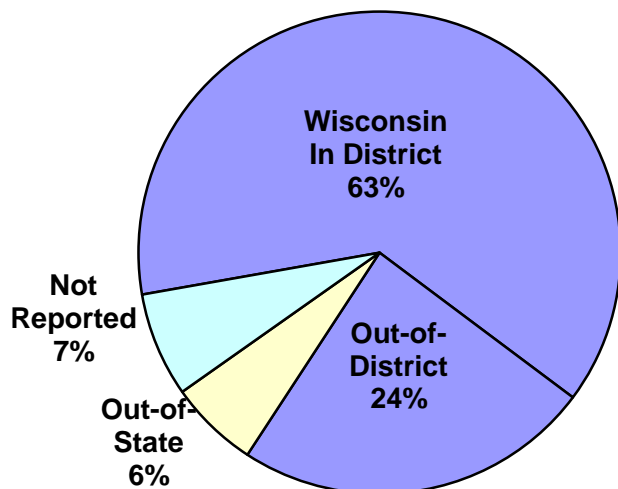
Statewide in all instructional areas, 71% of the employed graduates who responded to the survey obtained employment in occupations related to their training. The chart below shows the percent of those employed related for each instructional area from the highest percentage employed related (Agribusiness) to lowest (Graphic & Applied Arts).

### WHEN EMPLOYED

Of the 11,969 respondents who reported being employed, 47% said they became employed after their technical college training; 21% indicated they were employed before they enrolled; 15% said they got a job while they were attending technical college; and 17% did not indicate when they became employed.

### EMPLOYMENT LOCATION



**Technical college graduates overwhelmingly stay to live and work in Wisconsin and contribute to the state's economy.** Eighty-seven percent of the employed graduates who responded to the survey are working in Wisconsin (63% are employed in the technical college district where they received their training and 24% are employed in another district) six percent are employed out-of-state and seven percent did not indicate where they are employed.
