Whether you want to start with career-focused education or a more general path and transfer into a four-year university, a technical college will provide everything you need to transition and succeed.

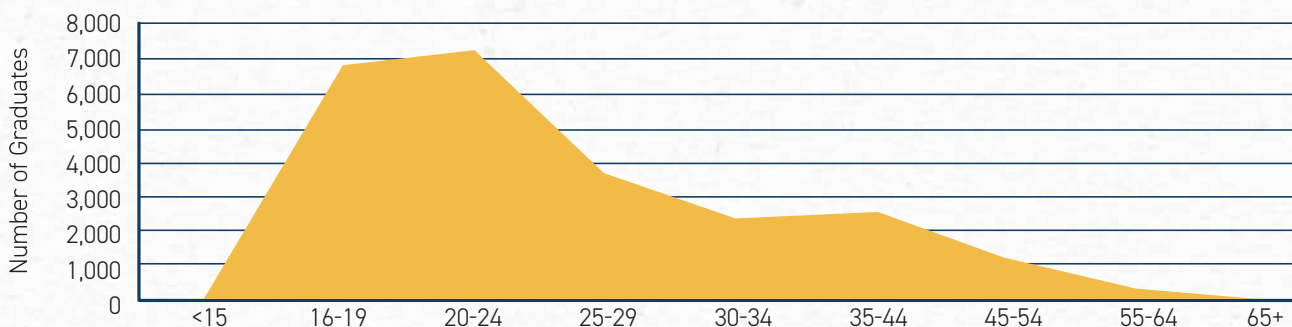

DEGREES FOR EVERY NEED

CAREER PATHWAYS HELP YOU START SMALL AND DREAM BIG.

CERTIFICATES

Short-term certificates meet employers' custom needs for skills or certifications in business, health, trade and industry.

SHORT-TERM PROGRAM

These programs focus on custom skills related to specific jobs and can often take less than one year to complete.

TECHNICAL DIPLOMA (one or two years of full-time study)

Technical diploma programs deliver hands-on learning and are offered at all Wisconsin technical colleges.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE (60-70 credits)

All Wisconsin technical colleges offer two-year programs requiring about 60 semester credits leading to an associate degree.

TRANSFER TO A FOUR-YEAR

Many credits transfer into four-year degree programs. This is an affordable way to begin your four-year degree.

Here's a quick overview of the types of degrees you can earn at a Wisconsin technical college (either before or after completing a bachelor's degree), expanding your career potential.

CERTIFICATE (typically six months or less)

- » Entry-level or specific skill-related credentials for quick employment gains

TECHNICAL DIPLOMA (one- to two-year programs)

- » Real-world programs created with employer input
- » Typically one to two years to complete full time

ASSOCIATE DEGREE (two-year programs)

- » Academic degree with a focus on hard and soft skills
- » Typically two years to complete full time
- » May build on smaller credentials (certificates, degrees and diplomas)

APPRENTICESHIP (journeyworker status)

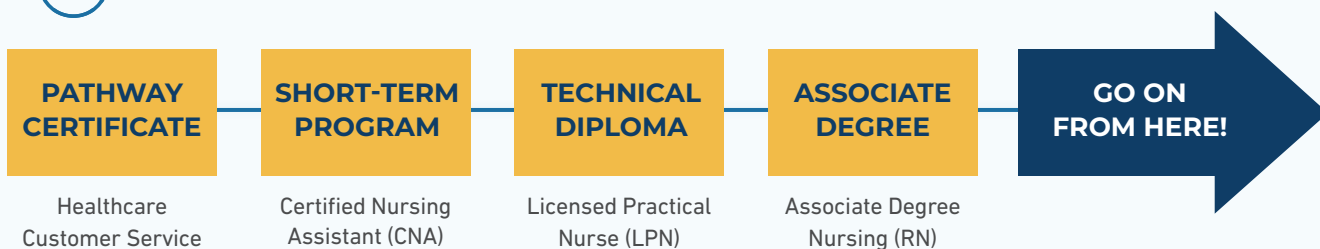

- » Participating employers pay for supervised, structured on-the-job training and classroom learning
- » Prepares skilled tradespeople to enter the workforce with a median salary of \$81,000+/year (six months after completion)

There are as many possible paths as there are technical college students. Even while working toward a high school diploma, a student may begin to take college courses, either through dual credit opportunities or through youth apprenticeships.

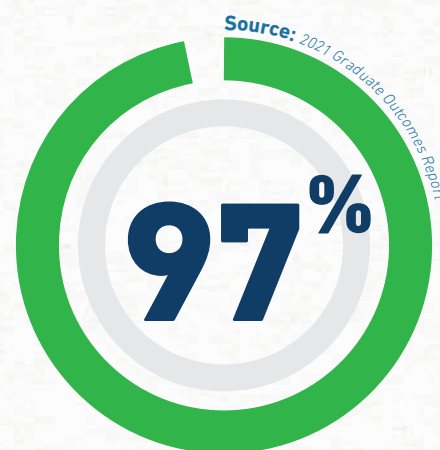
ADVANCED STANDING AND TRANSCRIPTED CREDIT

You can earn college credits before starting college. In fact, the more college credits you earn in high school, the further you will be on your pathway toward a college degree. Some students who plan carefully may even complete a college degree or diploma while in high school. This early entry into the pathway helps you get a head start, saving you time and money.

START COLLEGE NOW

Juniors and seniors who qualify while in high school can take college courses at a Wisconsin technical college. Approved courses count toward high school graduation and college credit.

YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP

Youth Apprenticeship offers great opportunities for high school students. Participating students can explore college courses and related careers on the way to high school graduation. The employer pays the college costs and pays the student for part-time work under the supervision of a skilled mentor.

TRANSFER OPTIONS

YOUR LIFE. YOUR COLLEGE. YOUR PATH.

College is a big decision and a big investment. Consider a more approachable path with a short-term or two-year program and gradually work up to a bachelor's degree (or more). Wisconsin technical colleges offer a variety of certificates and degrees designed to build on each other, giving you several options for degree completion and job advancement.

DID YOU KNOW? Many people who have earned a bachelor's degree return to a technical college to learn new or different skills, or to prepare for a technical occupation with more in-demand and high-paying job opportunities.



TRANSFER CREDITS TO A TECHNICAL COLLEGE

If you previously attended another college or university, you may be able to transfer credits, receive existing credits or earn new credits for skills and knowledge you gained at that college. Wisconsin technical colleges also grant college credit for career-related learning, work experience and military service.



TRANSFER CREDITS TO A UNIVERSITY

All 16 technical colleges have program-specific transfer agreements with four-year private colleges and universities and the University of Wisconsin System as well as some colleges and universities in other states.

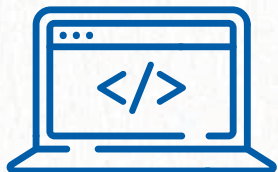

PROMISE PROGRAMS & OTHER SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Many of Wisconsin's technical colleges are making college possible for qualified, low-income students in their respective technical college districts. Promise programs are funded privately through relationships the technical colleges have with local partners. These programs allow new high school graduates — who otherwise may be unable to attend technical college because of low family income — to earn a degree tuition-free. Check with your technical college of choice to see if they offer these opportunities.

EDVEST 529 COLLEGE SAVINGS PLAN

The Edvest College Savings Plan is a college savings plan designed to make it easy to save for college while creating tax advantages — even on a modest budget. Open an account with as little as \$25 per investment option. Some contributions may be Wisconsin tax-deductible up to a certain amount; learn more at edvest.com.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

**CAN MAKE A HUGE DIFFERENCE
WHEN IT COMES TO YOUR EDUCATION.**

There are numerous scholarships, grants and other aid programs offered federally and locally that may go unclaimed. Every little bit helps, so check with your college's financial aid office to see if you may qualify for scholarships.



FINANCIAL AID

Students who are interested in financial aid should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Many factors determine the level and types of aid students receive. Learn whether you qualify for state and federal financial aid programs at **fafsa.gov**. You won't know if you are eligible for financial aid unless you apply. It's well worth the effort.

For more information about federal student aid programs, eligibility and the application process, consult the U.S. Department of Education website **studentaid.gov**. Students interested in financial aid need to complete the FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 for enrollment the following fall.

COLLEGE GOAL WISCONSIN EVENTS

College Goal volunteers help students and families complete financial aid application forms, including the FAFSA. There are typically more than 30 events around the state between November and January. Learn more at **collegegoalwi.org**.

SHARED PROGRAMS

To provide more program options, a college may collaborate on, or share, a program with another college, offering some classes at each institution. Students seeking financial aid must apply at the degree-granting college that will process and pay the financial aid.
