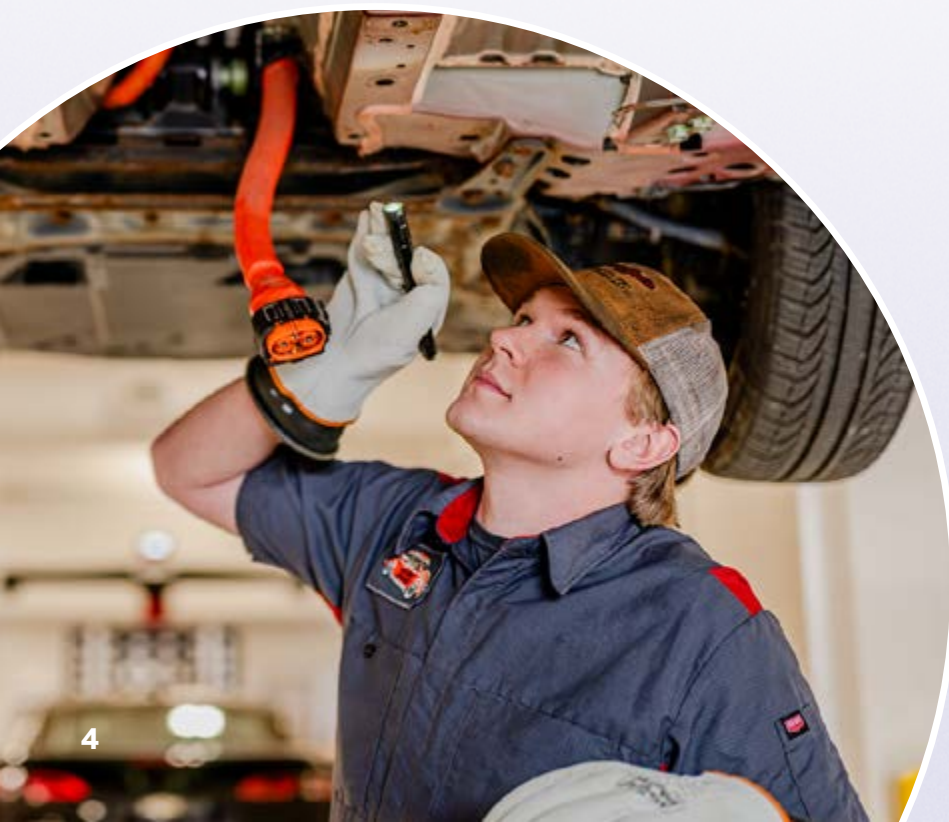

Where program-to-program transfer agreements exist between technical colleges and universities, certain credits earned may transfer, but credits are commonly geared to practical, career-specific education.

● AA or AS Degrees (also called Liberal Arts or University Transfer)

An Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree assures credits transfer into four-year degree programs, providing an affordable way to begin your bachelor's degree.

● Apprenticeship

A new kind of classroom where state-registered employers pay for supervised, structured, on-the-job training and classroom learning. It prepares skilled tradespeople to enter the workforce, with a median salary for all apprentices surpassing \$96,000/year.

Advanced standing and transcribed credit

Did you know you can earn college credits while in high school? The more college credits you earn in high school, the closer you will be to earning your college degree. Some students who plan carefully may even complete a college degree or diploma while still in high school. This valuable opportunity gives you a head start on your degree while saving you time and money.

Start college now

If you're a qualifying junior or senior in high school, you can take college courses at a Wisconsin Technical College. Approved courses count toward high school graduation and college credit.

Transfer pathways

Your credits can move with you as your goals evolve. Wisconsin's technical colleges offer various credits that when combined create credentials of increasing value, from certificates to diplomas and degrees, so you can advance at your own pace. You can take breaks between credentials and/or change institutions to build on your credentials and improve your career potential.

Transfer credits IN to a technical college

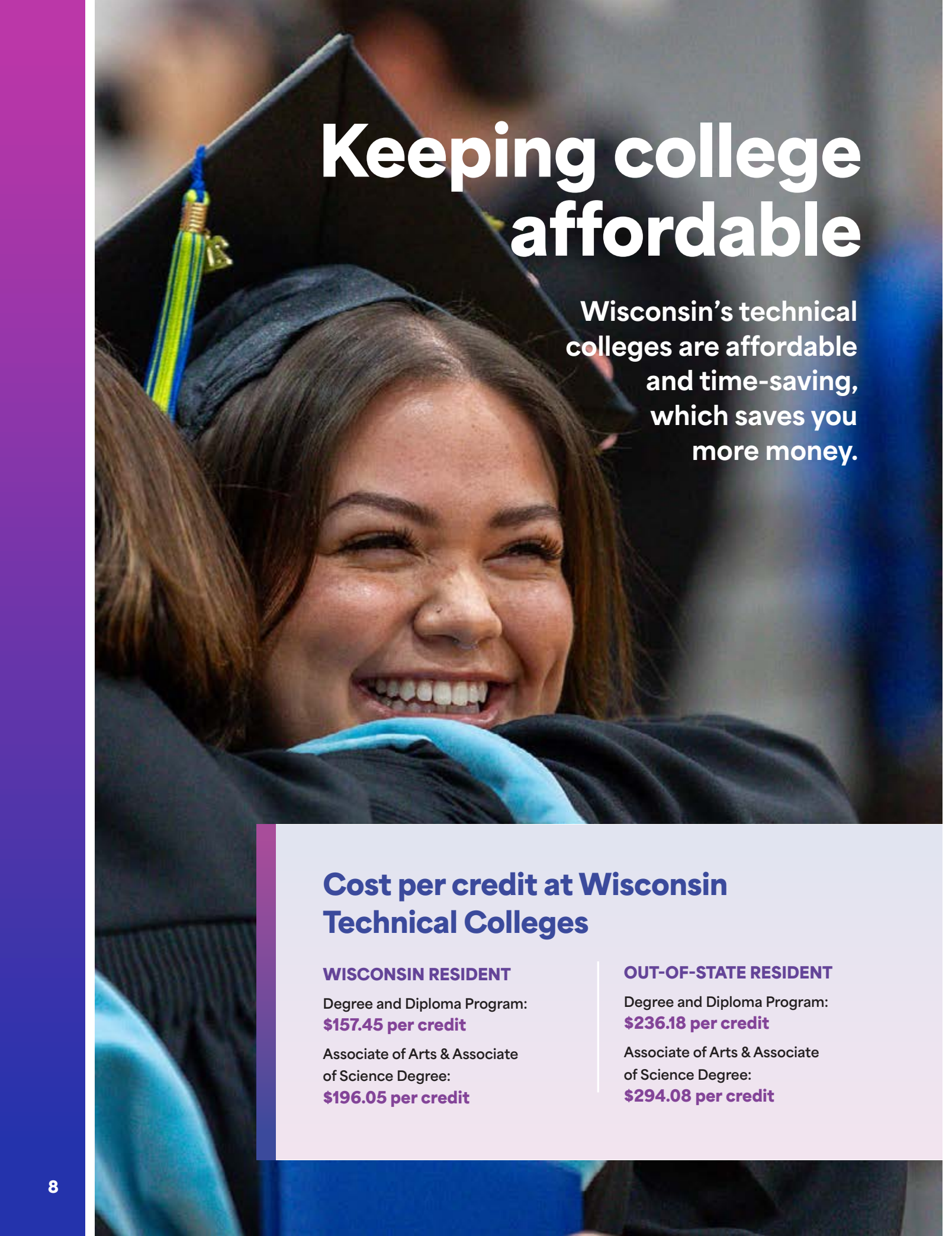
If you have previously attended another college or university, you can transfer existing credits or earn new credits for skills and knowledge you gained at that college. Wisconsin's technical colleges also grant college credit for career-related learning, work experience and military service.

NOTE: You should verify your credit transfer status with both institutions to ensure you will qualify.

OUT

Transfer credits OUT to a 4-year University or College

All 16 technical colleges have program-specific transfer agreements with four-year private colleges and universities, including the Universities of Wisconsin. Many transfer agreements also exist between colleges and universities in other states. Wisconsin's technical colleges also offer an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree (also called University Transfer). If eligible, you'll receive junior status when transferring into a college at the Universities of Wisconsin.

● Promise Programs and Other Scholarship Opportunities

Many of Wisconsin's technical colleges are making college possible for qualified, low-income students in their respective technical college districts. Promise programs are funded privately through relationships with local partners. These programs allow new high school graduates – who otherwise may be unable to attend technical college because of low family income – to earn a degree tuition-free.

Check with your technical college of choice to see if it offers these opportunities.

● Financial Aid

Students seeking financial aid should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA determines whether you can receive state and/or federal funding. You will only know if you are eligible for financial aid if you apply. It's well worth the effort. Some helpful resources are available from the U.S. Dept. of Education at fafsa.gov. You can also contact your chosen college's financial aid department to confirm due dates, ask questions, etc. The FAFSA application cycle occurs from October 1 through June 30. Since awards are made on a first-come, first-serve basis, please complete the FAFSA as soon as possible to improve your chances of receiving aid.

● Edvest 529 College Savings Plan

The Edvest College Savings Plan is designed to make it easy to save for college while creating tax advantages, even on a modest budget. Open an account with as little as \$25 per investment option. Some contributions may be tax-deductible up to a certain amount. Learn more at edvest.com.

● College Goal Wisconsin Events

College Goal Event volunteers help students and their families complete financial aid application forms, including the FAFSA. Between November and January, there are typically over 30 events across the state. Learn more at collegegoalwi.org.

● Shared Programs

To provide more program options, a college may collaborate on (or share) a program with another college, offering some classes at each institution. Students seeking financial aid must apply at the degree-granting college that will process and pay the financial aid.
